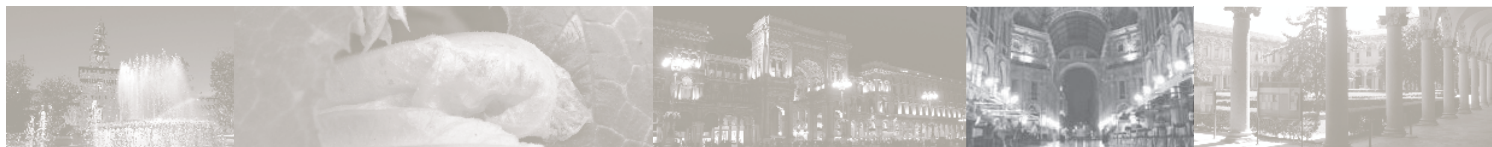
Chairmen and speakers at abstract presentation sessions are asked to make verbal statements. The audience, speakers, and chairmen are entitled to request such statements if they are not made.

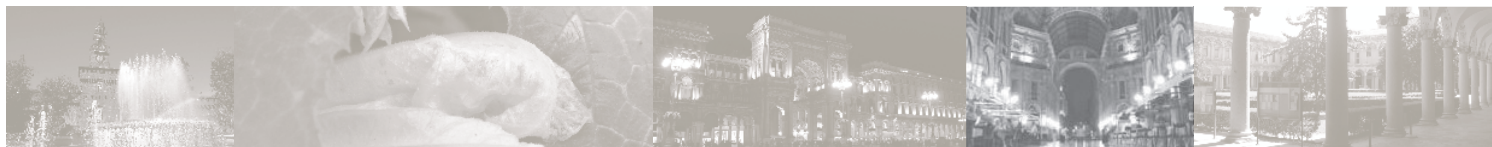

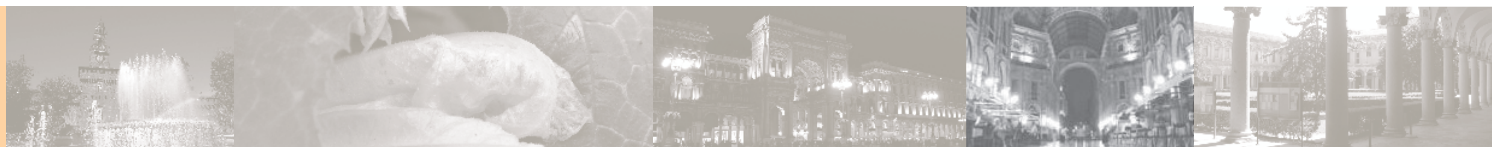
